

Red Wine

PEIRANO ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2014 Lodi , California \$36/8

Bright medium ruby. Superripe aromas of blackberry, cassis, mocha, coffee and molten bitter chocolate, complemented by nutty oak tones. Plush, dense and fine-grained, offer outstanding concentration and lightly saline character to the flavors of dark berries, mocha and coffee. The finish is elegant.

PEIRANO ESTATE SIX CLONES MERLOT 2014 Lodi, California \$36/8

The Six Clones is a seamless effort that remarkably demonstrates it's Right Bank counterparts . Sweet black cherry, white chocolate, smoke, and cocoa aromas jump from the glass of this dark purple-colored wine. Supple tannins, a velvety mouthfeel, and a lush, heady finish exhibiting serious concentration .

ZORZAL TERRIOR UNICO MALBEC 2014 Tupungato, Argentina \$38/9

From the highest part of the department of Tupungato in the Valle de Uco. It's very perfumed and spicy, aromatic in a way that makes you go to the glass over and over again. The palate has electricity and the Gualtallary chalkiness making for supple notes of raspberries, red currants, saline flavors and a very long finish.

PRIMARY WINES PINOT NOIR 2015 Sonoma, California \$44/10

Deeply saturated modern Pinot. This sexy Pinot Noir nose offers cherry, earth, spices and pepper plus a faint meaty nuance. Supple, spicy and concentrated, but without any undue weight. Simply wonderful.

MONTEFRESCO MONTEPULCIANO 2014 Abruzzo, Italy \$32/8

Fantastic. Inky ruby. Burnished aromas and flavors of dark plum, blackberry jam, coffee, cocoa, flint and dried flowers. Stunning voluptuous texture on the palate with great breadth. Balanced acidity gives this long, rich, subtle wine an elegant character and wonderful definition. Just beautiful!

White Wine

MONTEFRESCO PINOT GRIGIO 2015 Veneto, Italy \$32/8

A wine of acidity and depth, the 2015 delivers far and beyond your standard Pinot Grigio. Impresses for its distinctly stony, mineral-driven personality and overall sense of structure. White stone fruits, slate, crushed rocks and flowers meld into the tense finish. It boasts more complexity that you might expect. Thanks to the finish a caressing mouthfeel and tangy finish leaves the palate.

MASSEY DACTA SAUVIGNON BLANC 2015 Marlborough, New Zealand \$34/9

Massey Dacta exudes lovely tropical notes to accent a core of fresh grapefruit, baker's yeast and elderflower plus nuances of crushed stones and dill seed. Medium-bodied with wonderful concentration and flavor layers that provide punchy citrus fruits and yeastiness, it finishes long.

PRIMARY CHARDONNAY 2014 Lodi, California \$36/10

Pale yellow. Finely-etched citrus and orchard fruit scents, with a chalky accent adding vibrancy. Taut and sharply focused, conveying good thrust to its Meyer lemon, orange blossom, pear flavors and hazelnuts. Shows a richer fig quality on the penetrating, very long finish.

ANTHONY NAPPA LUMINOUS RIESLING 2015 Finger Lakes, New York \$40/10

Full of fruit in its youth, this shows plenty of concentration. Rather tropical, it seems packed with pear and peach, the sugar coming through and very much changing the flavor profile of this wine. It is quite delicious showing balance, with some grip on the finish and plenty of tasty fruit on the back palate.

Rose Wine

SAINT ROCH TOURAINE ROSE de LOIRE 2015 Loire Valley, France \$36/9

Distinctively delicious and intriguingly complex wine. Scents of hibiscus, red raspberry and lemon oil inform a high-toned, acidic nose. Gripping zest, crushed cherries, strawberries and invigoratingly on the palate, it develops aromatic aromas, finishing with outrageous bracing intensity.

Sparkling Wine

MONTEFRESCO PROSECCO GLERA DOC NV Veneto, Italy \$36/10

Montefresco exudes pure energy and vibrancy in its white peaches, jasmine, fresh baked bread and crushed rocks. The Brut is an intense, sinewy Prosecco that impresses for its balance, focus and mineral-drenched finish.
